1. เป็นข้าราชการสังกัดสำนักงานคณะกรรมการการอาชีวศึกษา ตั้งแต่ระดับปฏิบัติการขึ้นไป หรือเทียบเท่า หรือมีคุณสมบัติอื่นๆ ตามที่กำหนดไว้ในระเบียบว่าด้วยการให้ข้าราชการไปศึกษา ฝึกอบรม และดูงาน ณ ต่างประเทศ (กขต.) โดยรับราชการไม่น้อยกว่า 1 ปี นับถึงวันปิดรับสมัคร และมีคุณสมบัติตามที่กรป. กำหนดในรายละเอียดแบบพิมพ์ทุน 2 ดังเอกสารที่แนบ

The Embassy of the Arab Republic of Egypt in Bangkok presents its compliments to the Thailand International Cooperation Agency (TICA), and has the honor to inform that the Egyptian International Center for Agriculture (EICA) is granting **five full** scholarships and **five partial** scholarships to Thai agricultural related experts for training courses in ten different fields during 2020. The courses are as follows:

Each country can nominate a maximum of two candidates for each course, one primary and another secondary, noting that the latter will bear the cost of his/her flight ticket. Total number of nominations for full scholarships must not exceed five courses only.



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The registration forms and nomination papers should be submitted at least four months prior to the starting date of each course to allow ample time for review and processing of applications.

The Egyptian International Center for Agriculture (EICA) will provide each primary candidate with a round trip ticket, full board accommodation in a double room, health care (in case of emergency), and a per diem of 50 Egyptian Pounds. Secondary candidates will enjoy the same privileges minus the roundtrip ticket which will be borne by the sending country/candidate as mentioned above.

All candidates must have good working knowledge and understanding of either English, French, or Spanish language. The language of instruction in all taught courses and lectures will be in English.

The Embassy would highly appreciate if the esteemed Agency could forward this information to the Thai agricultural related experts; and appreciates receiving the documents of the nominees wishing to attend these courses at the earliest convenience. For a complete list of rules and conditions governing the application process, kindly refer to the attached EICA General Rules brochure.

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General Rules

Participants for the courses should:

- Have a good knowledge of either English/French/Spanish language that would enable him/her to follow-up the course, a certificate should be presented in this regard.
- A graduate of agricultural colleges or institutes. Priority shall be given to those with more than three years of professional experience in case of submission of more than one candidate.
- Primary candidates should preferably be less than 40 years old, and secondary candidates less than 45 years of age.
- Submit a medical certificate with their application to confirm that the nominee does not have any infectious diseases (including and not restricted to HIV/AIDS & Hepatitis C), physical or mental illnesses, taking into consideration that an HIV/AIDS tests will be conducted upon arrival in Cairo.
- Prepare a report on the nature of his/her work and problems facing the topic of the course to be attended. The report should be submitted during the first week of the course and would be discussed in a session.
- Candidates shall bear all visa expenses upon submission of their visa applications to the Egyptian Embassy in Bangkok.
- Candidates will bear the expense of his/her return ticket, if they depart before the end of the course notwithstanding the reasons for departure.
- Each country can nominate two candidates for the same course (the second candidate will only bear cost of his/her flight ticket).

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY:

1- AIR TICKETS AND FLIGHT SCHEDULE:

- * All reservation shall be made according to IATA regulations . Changes of such reservations normally imply extra costs not to be supported by EICA.
- * Flights will be booked by EICA starting from your recognized capital city to Cairo. The Egyptian Embassy in your country will provide you with all the necessary details.
- * It is important that you obtain a valid entry visa for Egypt from the Egyptian Diplomatic mission in your country before departure.
- * Return-tickets will be booked from Cairo to the final destination at the end of the course using the same routing of your arrival trip.
- * You can only be received at the Cairo Airport in case the flight schedule established by EICA remains unchanged, or if EICA has been duly informed in advance the exact date and time of your arrival and flight details.

- * Please note that any expenses incurred during or before your trip to Egypt and vice versa will not be covered by EICA, as to our rules.

2- ARRIVAL DETAILS:

- * Upon arrival at Cairo International Airport kindly report to the immigration and visa officer at the arrival hall to obtain a temporary stay for the course duration . Claim your baggage and find your way outside the transit area, **Please ignore tourist agencies and / or taxi drivers.**
- * Make yourself known to EICA representative/driver who will be expecting you **OUTSIDE** the arrival hall at the airport. Regardless to whether the day is an official holiday or not , our representative will be expecting you, holding (EICA) sign. Please keep an open eye on the signs. In case of failure in meeting our representative please proceed to the city , a distance of some 25 Km . We recommend that you use a BLACK Limousine this is a taxi service, be careful to get receipt from the driver ,
Show the taxi driver the attached Hotel Card and/or the EICA Card for guidance from the airport to the City .

AVOID reporting to any hotel other than the one authorized by EICA under any circumstances .

3- BOARD, LODGING and PERSONAL EXPENSES:

- * Throughout the course, EICA will provide you with B _ B accommodation (on double-room occupancy basis) at a contracted hotel , Lunch and dinner allowances.
- * A daily allowance of L.E. 50.00(Fifty)Egyptian-Pounds will be granted to participants for the duration of their stay to cover incidental expenses such as laundry , telephone calls , etc. the allowance, however, will not cover personal expenditure in all cases.

4- COUNTRY REPORTS:

- * The course is designed for specialists and practitioners in the above Mentioned subject matter, aiming at refreshing their knowledge and experiences through presentations, field trips and study tours .
- * We are asking you to prepare a detailed typed **COUNTRY REPORT** (8 - 10) pages reviewing your government strategies, also, reflecting progress and constraints in the subject matter of the course .

- * It would be advisable for you to collect all data required for this report before leaving your home country so that you might be able to submit the report to the Center within a week of your arrival in Egypt.
- * Presentation of the report will last for some twenty minutes using audio visual aids followed by questions and answers .

5- GENERALITIES:

- *Please note that the class presentations are offered in English Language with simultaneous translation / Interpretation into French and Spanish Languages.
- * Fridays and Saturday are official holidays in Egypt. Yet, EICA security guards are always available over the (24hrs) of the day .
Please note that EICA has (3) entrances along the same road.

We're highly honored to inform you that the work plan of the Egyptian International Center for Agriculture (EICA), during the coming year 2020, has been set to implement training programs and courses at the periods indicated below for every program:

The Government of the Arab Republic of Egypt has assigned the granted scholarships as follows:

- 1- Five (5) full scholarships and other additional scholarships to all African countries and some Asian countries throughout the year, noting that additional scholarships don't include Air tickets.
- 2- Scholarships granted to the Black Sea States Organization (BSEC), whose members are 11 countries with one full scholarship per state annually.

To this effect, EICA authorizes Embassies of Arab Republic of Egypt in the invited countries the authority to finally select the nominees before submitting them to the Egyptian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. In order to do so, EICA suggests for the Embassy to make a personal interview with the candidate before submitting nominations to the Egyptian Ministry of foreign Affairs or to EICA, to ensure that they meet the course admission requirements, in addition to acquainting them with EICA's activities and the candidate's commitments, also the commitments of the Government of the country that they belong to and the facilities to be provided by Egypt to the candidate through EICA during the course period in accordance to the candidate's letter, a copy of which is to be delivered to each candidate to act accordingly.

The following are the terms of nomination for EICA scholarships to act accordingly:

1. Ensure that the candidate has a good knowledge in one of the languages (English – French – Spanish) to enable him/her to properly follow the training and to benefit from the implemented programs, noting that all lectures are directly delivered in English and that Arabic language is never used in the lectures, with simultaneous translation of two languages (French Spanish).
2. To apply to EICA programs, it's required to hold an agricultural university or institute degree, priority is given to those who have experience of not less than three years in the respective training topic to which the nominee applies.
3. Requesting from every nominee to submit a medical certificate reporting that he/she is free from infectious and viral diseases and HIV disease; stating that the candidate is medically and psychologically fit to travel and attend the program, to be sent with the nomination in compliance to the directives of the Ministry of Health in this respect.
4. It's necessary for the candidate to prepare a printed report on the nature of his/her work (country Report), including specific problems confronted in the domain of duty in his/her country, to be discussed at special sessions within the training program.
5. The granted scholarship of the Arab Republic of Egypt (Egyptian International Center for Agriculture) includes the following facilities:
 - A. Provide a travel ticket to Cairo and return back at the end of the program to the capital city of the delegate's country, that's only for the principal candidate , noting that EICA doesn't bear any other expenses beyond the borders of Egypt.
 - B. Ensure full accommodation to the delegate during the program at contracted hotels, in double rooms.
 - C. Ensure a daily pocket money of - (-) Egyptian pounds to meet personal casual need
 - D. Health care is ensured for emergency cases only.

6. EICA does not admit any nomination after the beginning of the training program, only in exceptional cases (such as incomplete scheduled number of nominations).
7. It's preferable for a candidate not to exceed the age of (40) years, the additional nominee could be accepted up to (45) years.
8. It's necessary to act strictly in selecting or rejecting candidates to avoid apologies from candidates to attend after being accepted.
9. All nominations should be delivered to EICA, for a maximum of one months before the program starting date.
10. It's preferable for the country's nominations for the calendar year of 2020 to be one batch, to enable EICA to book accommodation for the final nominees in accordance to the received nominations. The priority will be given to final and confirmed nominations from the concerned authorities to avoid travel ticket cancelation after issuance and the resulting consequences of financial fines.
11. In case of departure of the candidate before the scheduled end of the program for any reason whatsoever, the responsibility of the candidate's return back and the cost of return ticket adjustment fine is to be beard by the candidate.

It's worth to mention that sending the travel ticket to the finally assigned nominee from the side of the Egyptian Embassy is subject to his/her signature on the attached pledge which states the receipt of the nomination letter, His/her acquaintance with the entire commitments and the facilities provided from the Egyptian Government. Non commitment to travel at the assigned date of the ticket would involve a considerable financial penalty will never be incurred by EICA under whatsoever conditions, hence the candidate who wishes to modify his/her travel date according to an emerging situation, shall bear the travel ticket fine at his/her own expense.

The Egyptian International Center for Agriculture kindly requests sending a copy of the nominee's passport in addition to his/her personal email, to enable us issue the travel ticket without any error in the name, in the appropriate time before the program starting date, it's also appropriate to send a copy of the nomination directly to EICA in case of delay behind appropriate time to the following address, along with sending the original nomination document to the Cultural Sector of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs through the candidate's Embassy.

INTRODUCTION

The Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries received an invitation from the Embassy of the Arab Republic of Egypt in Pretoria to participate in the 2020 International Training Programmes. These programmes are fully funded by the Egyptian International Centre for Agriculture (EICA) in Egypt. EICA will pay for international airfare (return economy airfare), training expenses, full-board accommodation, and domestic transport within the programmes, free medical care and pocket money allowance.

EICA maintains a strong network with various Research Institutions, Universities, Public and Private Sector Enterprises as well as, Tutors, Trainers, Resource Persons and Experts working in such organizations that are recruited to share their expertise with EICA participants. The training programs are oriented in such a way to ensure coverage of the subject matter in question both from the theoretical and the practical points of view. Usually, (35 - 40%) of the total course duration is dedicated to lectures & presentations, while the remaining percentage emphasizes the practical aspects.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION:

- An agricultural education, at least BSc degree in Agriculture
- Having work experience in the field for a minimum of three years.
- Committed to continue work in the same field after the termination of the course.
- Having a good command of spoken and written English and/or French and/or Spanish.
- Healthy enough to participate actively in the course (attach medical report proving free contagious diseases)
- Must be below the age of 45 years
- Must be English proficient

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Introduction:

The International training course on Poultry Production and Health is organized by the Egyptian International Centre for Agriculture (EICA) for trainees from the agricultural sector and its related disciplines, nominated from countries of Africa, Asia, Latin America and Eastern Europe, with a minimum of three years experience in the field of Poultry Production and Health. The course is conducted in English language with simultaneous interpretation into French and Spanish.

1.1. Course Title:

"POULTRY PRODUCTION AND HEALTH"

1.2. Duration of the Course:

The training program will start on July 10th till September 25th 2015 for duration of almost eleven weeks.

1.3. Objectives of the course

This course is designed to provide the participants with knowledge and techniques necessary for increasing poultry production & enhancing veterinary care in their own regions. It also aims at refreshing and upgrading their relevant experiences and practices in animal husbandry in general.

Expected Outputs:

- Understanding the role of genetic structure in breeding programmes for producing high quality chicks.
- Identifying factors controlling nutritional deficiencies and nutritional requirements in poultry feed formulation.
- Comprehending basic principles of poultry farm management through practical application.
- Exchanging information and expertise between Egypt and other countries.

1.4. Implementing Agent:

- EICA is a Training Centre belonging to Foreign Agricultural Affairs that affiliated to the Egyptian Ministry of Agriculture and Land Reclamation.
- In 1965, EICA has started its training activities targeting the developing countries in Africa and Asia.
- EICA has achieved (72) regular training programs since 1965 till 1982 and (300) programs during the years of 1983 to 2012. It also implemented about (300) special programs since 1966 till 2012.

- English is the official language of instruction for EICA training courses accompanied by simultaneous translation for French and Spanish languages.
- EICA training courses are focusing on topics of agricultural sciences that related to agricultural production and development.
- EICA has trained more than 20,000 participants from 120 countries since its inception.
- EICA maintains a strong network with several Research Centers and Institutions, Universities, Public and Private Enterprises and Agencies.

1.5. Course Methodology:

Participants will be provided with various instructive and training methodologies throughout the program. Almost one third of the course duration will be spent in the lecture room for theoretical deliberation, group discussions and workshops. The course will be conducted in the form of Modules. Each module will start with conceptual Lecture regarding the stipulated topics in this field. This practice usually takes place at EICA premises in Cairo, Egypt. The remaining proportion of the course emphasizes the practical training, whereby participants are given the opportunity to visit laboratories for demonstration work, also participate in field visits and study tours for practical training. The main locations for such practices will be available at the research centers of Ministry of Agriculture, laboratories of Faculty of Agriculture and some private enterprises.

1.6. Tentative Curriculum of the Program

Course curriculum:

The curriculum of the course will be in the form of modules; this course is mainly about Poultry Production and Health. The content of the modules can be adjusted or increased according to the need of the majority of participants.

Module I: Poultry Production:

- Heredity & Selection
- Breeding
- Nutrition
- Management
- Economics

Module II: Poultry Health

Module III: Extension in Poultry Production

Workshop & Case study:

- Participants will be divided into groups according to the materials used in the project.
- Each group will be asked to develop a project on Poultry Production and Health related to the practical training taken during the course.

Climate changing seminar

- You are kindly requested to prepare an article of not less than 5 pages on the impact of climate changes on environment and Poultry Production in your country to be presented on special sessions held during the course.

Country Report Presentation:

- Each participant must submit and give a country report presentation on IPM dealing with the main subjects of this course, beside it should include the constraints facing the production in his/her country.
- 20 minutes will be allocated to present the status of Poultry Production and Health in your country and 10 minutes more for different questions from other participants.
- Please make arrangements for delivering an electronic country report to the course administrator upon arrival into Egypt.

1.7. Completion Certificate:

- Pre and post exam will be prepared at the beginning of the course and by the end of it to clarify the extent of benefit of the course.
- A certificate of attendance is awarded at the end of the training course for active participation, attendance, assignment and contribution to the course.

11.1. Qualifications of Applicants:**Participants should be:**

- University graduated in the field of poultry production and health.
- Three years of working experience at least in the mentioned field.
- Age should not exceed 45 years old.
- Nominated by their governments.
- Committed to keep working in the field of poultry production and health.
- Good command of spoken and written English, and/or French and/or Spanish.
- A good health condition is highly recommended for active participation.
- Having no dietary restrictions and accept all provisions made to stay in Egypt with no complaints.

11.2 Procedures of Applicants:

The Governments who will nominate applicants to the mentioned course should forward ONE copy of the attached application form after being completed to (EICA) through the diplomatic channels (Egyptian Embassy or Consulate) within thirty (30) days before the commencement of the Course.

Applicants shall:

- Ascertain from the Egyptian Embassy or Consulate in his/her country about issues related to visa obtaining, money exchange and health regulations that are prevalent in Egypt.
- Make arrangements for any private financial issues which aren't supported by his/her Government or scholarship.
- Submit four passport size photographs to EICA upon arrival.

Nominating countries shall:

- Defray such incidental expenses as those related to passport, visas and vaccination, beside the usual salary and emoluments during the participation in the training course.
- Coordinate the transit charges during the trip to and from Egypt which are not supported by EICA.

Participants will be granted:

- Roundtrip economy class air ticket to and from the Capital city through the shortest and least expensive route.
- Half board accommodation throughout the duration of the training course.
- Allowance: Pocket money stipend at a rate of L.E. 50 (Fifty Egyptian Pounds) per day effective from day of arrival through day of departure, to cover any personal expenses.
- Medical treatment for minor ailments that occur during the course is covered by the sponsors, (costs related to pre-existing illness, chronic illness, pregnancy, or dental care are not included).
- Domestic transportation for locations related to the program is available throughout the course duration.

Participants are required to:

- 1- Arrive to Cairo not earlier than (2) two days before the inauguration of the course.
- 2- Assume responsibility for any expenses incurred during the trip between home and Egypt and vice versa. EICA does not support such expenses, especially if not justifiable.
- 3- Not to change or alter the course or to extend the program duration.
- 4- Devote his/her full time for the program and participate in all stages of the training course.
- 5- Not to bring any member of their families during the training course.
- 6- Not to leave Egypt before the end of the course (Not to return to their country or go to another country except for the case of humanity).
- 7- Observe the rules and regulations of the training center in which participants undertake study or training.
- 8- Refrain from engaging in political activities, or any form of employment for profit or gain.

1- Pre-departure instructions for the participants:

Participants are requested to report in person to the Egyptian diplomatic mission in their own country in order to complete the necessary procedures and obtain pre-departure instructions.

2- Visa: Before leaving their country, participants should obtain a visa for entry to Egypt. Visas will be issued by the Egyptian diplomatic missions in their country.

3- Air ticket:

- Participants are requested to arrive in and to leave Egypt on the dates designated for the course.
- The dates will be finally confirmed by the air-tickets sent to the participants through the travel agency.
- All flight routes included in the provided air-tickets are final.

4- Photographs: For administrative purposes, participants are requested to bring along with them to Egypt four (4) copies of a recent photograph (passport size).

5- Airports: At Cairo International Airport, a course assistant will be present to welcome the participant, and to arrange his/her transportation to the hotel.

In case of extreme necessity, participant can take a taxi with meter and proceed to the hotel if the bus of the center isn't at the airport, the fare can be paid by the receptionist in charge who will take a receipt from the driver in return.

6- Incidental Expenses: Participants are advised to carry some cash in US dollars for incidental expenses during their trip to Egypt and upon their arrival.

7- Climate: July is considered of summer season in Egypt with a temperature of maximum 35°C & minimum 25°C.

8- Currency: One US \$ approximately equals to 7.6 LE.

9- Working days: The official day off in Egypt are Fridays and Saturdays.

General Rules

- Prepare a report on the nature of his/her work and problems facing the topic of the course to be attended. The report should be submitted during the first week of the course and would be discussed in a session.
- Candidates shall bear all visa expenses upon submission of their visa applications to the Egyptian Embassy in Bangkok.
- Candidates will bear the expense of his/her return ticket, if they depart before the end of the course notwithstanding the reasons for departure.
- Each country can nominate two candidates for the same course (the second candidate will only bear cost of his/her flight ticket).

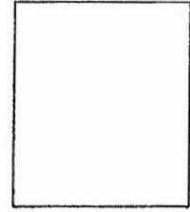
